## STATE OF DELAWARE DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE

Pursuant to <u>Regulation 1406</u>, Licenses shall remain in effect for 1 year unless sooner surrendered, suspended or revoked by the Commissioner.

The Department does not send out renewal notices. It is the Third Party Administrator's responsibility to submit a complete and correct Annual Renewal Filing. The renewal filing must be received on or before **July 1st annually\***. Please do not submit renewals or reports more than 60 days in advance.

The renewal filing for Third Party Administrators must contain the following:

- Annual Renewal Form with company and contact information.
- Audited Financial Report for the period ending 12/31/previous year certified by
  2 officers. (Resident Only)
- Certificate of Good Standing from Resident State (Non-Resident Only)
- Attach any Administrative Action and/or Notices from other states (Resident Only)
- \$100.00 annual fee made payable to the <u>Delaware Department of Insurance</u>.

\*Under <u>1400 Health Insurance Specific Provisions (delaware.gov)</u> any renewals not received by July 1<sup>st</sup> would be a violation and may result in the suspension or revocation of the company license or the imposition of a fine.
